We are happy to support you in this - with the „respect-code“ in our textiles: the origin and production conditions of the textile can be traced easily and directly along the entire supply chain. This is the best possible way to prepare yourself and your textiles for the EU's planned Digital

Product Passport (DPP), which is to be affixed to every textile placed on the EU market in future.

Sustainability without additional costs or effort for you - this is possible with the Mass Balance System from Cotton Made in Africa (CmiA). By implementing CmiA cotton in our supply chain, we support sustainable cotton cultivation in Africa and promote better living conditions for cotton farmers and their families. In addition, up to 13% less greenhouse gas emissions are produced compared to the global average, and a high level of drinking water savings is achieved locally through natural irrigation with rainwater. By purchasing Dibella products, you are also supporting the Cotton Made in Africa initiative. Do good and talk about it - we'll show you how!

Product transparency with the **respect-code**. In future, every textile placed on the market in the EU must be labelled with a digital product passport to facilitate reuse or recycling and at the same time make supply chains more transparent. At Dibella, disclosure has long been standard practice: items labelled with the respect-code document their entire life cycle.

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Dibella implements **Cotton made in Africa** cotton in the Mass Balance System in its supply chain, thereby promoting socially and ecologically sustainable cotton production in Africa. By purchasing the corresponding Dibella products, you are also supporting the initiative.


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Team News

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
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
